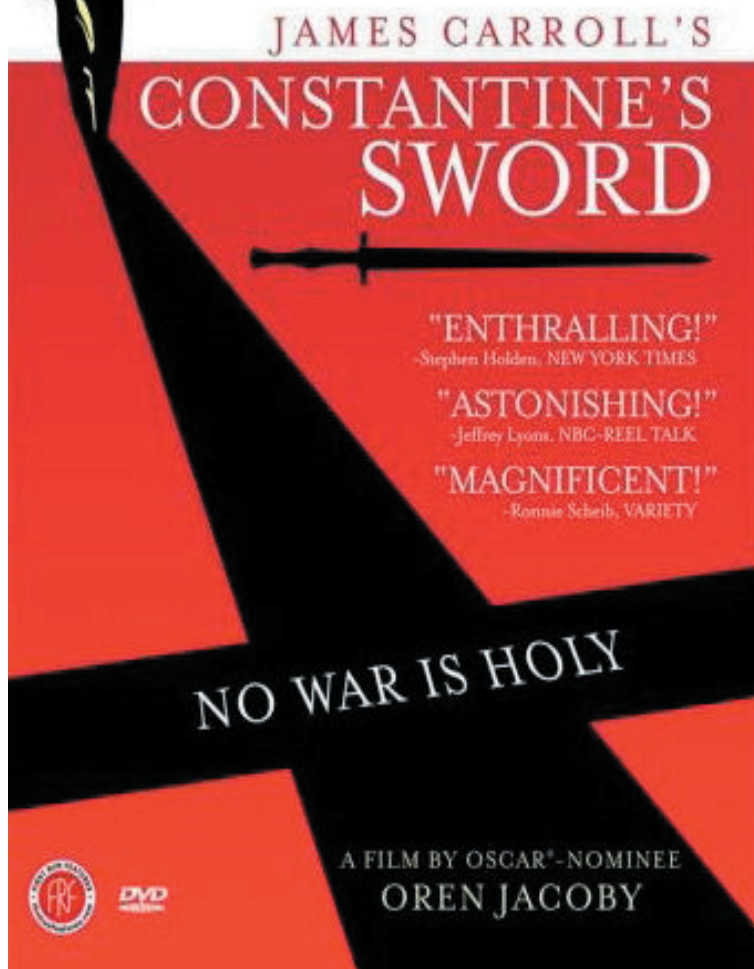

Inspired by the bestselling book by acclaimed author and former priest, James Carroll, this documentary brings to life a history of religious intolerance, tracing it as a source of war and the fanaticism that threatens the world today.

In the film (directed by Oscar nominated filmmaker Oren Jacoby), Carroll uncovers the terrible legacy that reverberates across the centuries—from Emperor Constantine's vision of the cross as a sword and symbol of power, to the rise of genocidal anti-Semitism and modern-day wars and conflicts sparked by religious extremism.

Carroll's journey takes him into his own past, coming to terms with his father's role as U.S. Air Force general preparing for nuclear war. From there, it carries him into the wider world, uncovering evidence of church-sanctioned violence against Jews, Muslims, and others, including how some evangelical Christians proselytize inside the armed forces.

At its core, *Constantine's Sword* is a compelling personal narrative — a kind of detective story — as one man uncovers the dark areas of history of his own faith and the church he loves.
